Hypertension and Cardiovascular Risk

- Diagnosis and management of high blood pressure (the clinic can arrange and report Ambulatory Blood Pressure Monitoring done at FMC)
- Identification of secondary causes of hypertension
- Assessment of overall cardiovascular risk for management decisions
- Assessment and management of orthostatic hypotension and other forms of low blood pressure
- Postpartum management of hypertension in women with pre-eclampsia

Information Required

- Reason for referral
- current medication list
- previous intolerance to specific drugs
- full medical history, including family history
- duration of hypertension

Investigations Required

- EUC, FBE, TFT, full lipid profile, fasting glucose
- Albumin/creatinine ratio (urine)
- (for known diabetics) latest HbA1C
- Results of any other investigations which GP has done specifically related to patient's hypertension or reason for referral

Red Flags

Red flags should prompt immediate GP referral to **Emergency Department**

- High blood pressure with:
 - recent onset of confusion or altered mental state
 - retinal haemorrhages and exudates (with or without papilloedema)
 - recent onset of chest pain, dyspnoea
 - new neurological signs/symptoms

Suggested GP Management

- In patients not on any medications we recommend 24 hour Ambulatory BP Monitoring ± Home BP (the clinic can arrange and report monitoring Ambulatory Blood Pressure Monitoring done at FMC)
- In patients with recently diagnosed essential hypertension consider first line treatment with
 - 1. Angiotensin-converting enzyme Inhibitor (ACEI)/ Angiotensin II Receptor Blocker (ARB)
 - 2. Calcium Channel Blocker (CCB)
- Lifestyle Changes
