

Emergency Use of Group O Red Blood Cells



Considerations



Uncrossmatched RBC are to be used only in an emergency to save a patient's life



A pretransfusion specimen must be obtained as soon as possible, and where practical, prior to transfusion of emergency RBC



Move to group specific/crossmatch compatible RBC as soon as possible



O RhD negative RBC need to be preserved for those patients who need it
