FACT SHEET – Midwifery Continuity of Care Experience (COCE) student recording in Placeright

Purpose

The purpose of this fact sheet is to provide a step by step guide for education provider (EP) staff on how to request COCE midwifery students in the clinical placement management system Placeright[™]

Overview

Based on the outcome of the recent COCE trial at Mount Gambier Health Service and following a recent SA Health Midwifery Coordinators meeting it was agreed that recording every SA Health student COCE occasion in detail would be too cumbersome; however, in 2020 all students that are part of this program will need to be recorded in the Placeright which will then

- Comply with SA Health Clinical Placement Agreement
- Act as a repository for COCE student names
- Track student names for orientation purposes

Pre- requisite

Education providers need to have a midwifery subject / study period set up in Placeright for recording of COCE students.

Placeright Facility setup in SA Health organisations

- Within each metropolitan midwifery service organisation (WCH, FMC, LMH) a Placeright facility name "MID_Continuity of Care Experience {COCE}" has been set up
- Within each regional midwifery service organisation the health service name will be in front of the facility e.g. Mount Barker DSMH Midwifery Continuity of Care Experience COCE {MID}, and have been set up

How to manage the COCE requests

- One generic Placeright placement booking needs to be requested by the education provider for each relevant year level (1, 2 or 3) with a date range for the whole year (Weeks 1 to 53 in 2020) against facilities within each partnership
- The student number in the booking will be dependent on the number of students in each year level requiring to follow women throughout their pregnancy in the COCE program



Note: If the number of students in each of the above categories exceeds 50 students, additional requests will need to be requested for ease of administration.

- The Placeright Placement Type will be "Integrated Midwifery" for these requests
- These placement request are to be confirmed by each relevant health site
- The students are then assigned / uploaded to the relevant placement bookings by the education providers progressively as the students confirm consensus of women involved
