South Australian Voluntary Assisted Dying Pharmacy Service (SAVAD-PS)

The <u>South Australian Voluntary Assisted Dying Pharmacy Service (SAVAD-PS)</u> provides the safe supply, education about, and disposal of voluntary assisted dying medication.

Part of <u>SA Pharmacy</u>, the <u>SAVAD-PS</u> works with the <u>South Australian Voluntary Assisted Dying Care</u> <u>Navigator Service</u> and medical practitioners to ensure continuity of care and support for people accessing voluntary assisted dying in South Australia.

<u>SAVAD-PS</u> is available statewide and can visit people who have a Self-administration Permit or medical practitioners with a Practitioner Administration Permit anywhere in South Australia to provide necessary information and supply the voluntary assisted dying medication.

SAVAD-PS is responsible for:

- supply of the voluntary assisted dying medication kit
- educating a person accessing voluntary assisted dying about the administration process
- educating the Contact Person about their responsibilities to return the medication
- educating medical practitioners about the medication-related aspects of the pathway
- facilitating the return and safe disposal of any unused voluntary assisted dying medication
- preparing and maintaining medication-related resources
- supporting healthcare services in the preparation and maintenance of medication-related governance.
