

SA Health Specialist Outpatient Clinics Waiting Time Report Census date as at 30 September 2021

This report details metropolitan specialist outpatient waiting times for Routine (category 2) and Non-urgent (category 3) patients who have not been given an appointment date at the census date (i.e. are unscheduled).
