

# OUTPATIENT SERVICE DESCRIPTION & TRIAGE GUIDELINES ALLERGY/CLINICAL IMMUNOLOGY SERVICE - ADULTS Southern Adelaide Local Health Network (SALHN)

#### **Description of Service**

The SALHN Allergy/Clinical Immunology (ACI) Service provides care to adults and transition care to children > 16 years with serious and complex allergic and immunologic disorders. The clinical assessment and management of patients is provided by a highly integrated, specialised multi-disciplinary team, consisting of medical staff, allergy nurses and dietitian.

#### Services provided

- Anaphylaxis
- Systematic Autoimmune Disease
- Urticaria
- <u>Recurrent Angioedema</u> (without urticaria) if C4 reduced or > 6 weeks duration.
- Drug Allergy
- Atopic Eczema
- Allergic Rhinoconjunctivitis
- Suspected Primary Immunodeficiency
- Complicated IgE mediated food allergy.

#### Services not provided

- Chronic cough
- Insect Sting reaction without anaphylaxis
- Allergic Rhinitis without trialled medical management
- Urticaria without trialled medical management
- Asthma
- Atopic Eczema without trialled medical management
- Contact Dermatitis
- Diarrhoea/constipation/bloating.
- Ongoing PBS Authority prescriptions for Adrenaline Auto Injector (EpiPen).
- Isolated Pruritus.
- Elevated ANA in absence of clinically relevant problem.
- Chronic infections (Rickettsia)
- Adverse non allergic drug reactions.
