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| Eligibility | - Flattening of the medial longitudinal arch of the foot  <br> +/-Associated pain. Especially if:  <br> $0 \quad$ Unilateral  <br> 0 Acquired ( flattening of the arch in adulthood) <br> 0 Rigid ( loss of normal hindfoot inversion/eversion) <br> $0 \quad$ Bony swelling on the medial border of the foot  |


| Pre-Referral <br> management <br> strategies (include <br> with referral) | 1. Supportive footwear ( usually lace up) +/- Foot orthotics (arch <br> supports) <br> 2. Analgesia |

| Discharge <br> Criteria/information | • Improving symptoms with non-operative management <br> - No pain or progression of deformity <br> - Red flags: Continuous symptoms despite the non-operative <br> management |
