Allied Health Cadetships

Cadetship Overview

The Yorke and Northern Local Health Network (YNLHN) Allied Health Cadetship program offers paid employment to local students studying an undergraduate or masters allied health course.

Cadets are employed by the local health services as an allied health assistant for the duration of the program then on graduation, are appointed an ongoing AHP1 position in their profession, pending eligibility for appointment.

The overall aim of the program is to:

- Provide an allied health education and workforce pathway for local students and job seekers to improve recruitment and retention of staff in the network
- Provide reliable high quality allied health services for the YNLHN community

Cadets

The Cadetship offers cadets:

- The opportunity to work in their Local Health Network in a range of settings such as hospitals, outpatient clinics and/or community while completing their allied health studies
- Allied Health Assistant employment and income while they study
- Support and mentoring by professionals already working in the health setting
- Commitment to ongoing AHP1 employment in their Local Health Network on successful completion of the cadetship

Eligibility

To be eligible for a cadetship, a person must be:

- A permanent resident of the YNLHN catchment area
- Enrolled in a degree or master's course that leads to professional registration, or eligibility for membership with a relevant professional association in one of the following
 - Speech Pathology
 - Occupational Therapy
 - Physiotherapy
 - Podiatry
- Studying full-time or part time (no less than 50% subject per year)
- Able to complete one assessed university student placement in their final 2 years at a YNLHN Health Facility

Applications and Further Enquiries:

Cadetship recruitment occurs February to March annually and applications open January 2025!

You do not need to be a first-year undergraduate or master's student to apply. The program accepts cadets from all year levels however you must be able to complete your full final year as a cadet to be eligible.
