

Reporting Challenging Behaviour on the Safety Learning System (SLS)

The Safety Learning System (SLS) supports our leaders to report, monitor and review local Challenging Behaviour incidents.

All Challenging Behaviour incidents must be reported.

Patient incidents

Reported by the Patient’s Home Team in the Patient Incident Module



Worker incidents

Reported by the Worker (or Worker’s Manager) in the Worker Incident Module



Security incidents

Reported by Security Staff on the Security Incident Module



CODE BLACK INCIDENTS

Every team must report individually in their own modules



Who reports it (for every incident)	Where do I report?
Patients home team	Patient Module
Security Staff (or equivalent)	Security Module
Worker/Worker’s Manager (If worker harmed/injured)	Worker Module
