That's why we're establishing GP Plus Health Care Centres and GP Plus Super Clinics in your community - so that you can get quality coordinated care close to home.

GP Plus centres and clinics will provide a wide range of services tailored to meet the needs of your local community, and may include:

- > GP services, including after-hours
- > Nursing and midwifery services
- > Allied health – podiatry, dental, physiotherapy and occupational therapy
- > Health education and counseling
- > Children and youth services
- > Drug and alcohol services
- > Community mental health services
- > Aboriginal health services
- > Other specialist services as required

GP Plus Health Care Centres and GP Plus Super Clinics will also provide advice on how to manage chronic (long-term) diseases such as diabetes, asthma and high blood pressure, as well as providing support for in-home care.

Additional services will also be available to provide guidance on staying fit and healthy.

Your local GP Plus Health Care Centre or GP Plus Super Clinic will have the right people, services and facilities on hand to keep you and your family happy and healthy, and take away the need to travel to an emergency department for minor illness or injury.
