Information Required

- Associated symptoms – pain or painless, fevers, weight loss
- History of previous biliary problems or surgery
- Findings on general and abdominal examination

Investigations Required

- Electrolytes, creatinine, LFTs, FBE, INR
- Liver and biliary tract US
