### **Tuberculosis**

Defined as

- Infection due to mycobacterium tuberculosis

## **Information Required**

- Duration of symptoms
- · Other co-morbidities
- Any ICU/HDU admissions
- Medication list
- Smoking status
- Travel history / immigrant status
- Immunosuppression
- Past history of tuberculosis contact

## **Investigations Required**

- Chest X-ray
- CBP
- LFT
- Sputum Acid Fast Bacilli (AFB))

# Red Flags should prompt immediate referral to Emergency Department

- Suspected active infection
- Fever
- Weight loss
- Cavity lung disease
- Haemoptysis

# **Suggested GP Management**

- Prompt referral
- Initial antibiotic treatment for possible infection other than tuberculosis
