Priority	Rapidly enlarging skin nodule
	Severely hyperkeratotic nodules
Differential Diagnoses	SCC, Merkel cell carcinoma, atypical fibroxanthoma, melanoma
Information required with referral	 Any skin biopsy/ excision reports Any radiological reports relevant to the skin with films to be sent with patient
Investigation required for diagnosis	If clinically suspicious the patients should be referred in urgently but a biopsy could be done if there is a significant wait
Pre-Referral	Refer urgently if rapidly growing nodule.
management	Examine rest of skin and for presence of lymphadenopathy
