Access criteria must be met for flexible nasendoscopic examination assessment:

- Cognition:
 - Clients are assumed to have behavioural and cognitive capacity to tolerate and cooperate with the nasendoscopic procedure Clients with cognitive/behavioural issues must be able to provide consent for the procedure personally or via NOK/guardian and be accompanied by a carer.
- **Mobility:** Independent mobility or wheelchair sitting stability is required for up to 2 hours.
- **Continence:** Independent toileting, carer-assisted toileting, or incontinence aids for protection is required.

Referral Letter should contain the following information:

Reason for referral: include history of onset of voice impairment

Relevant medical history: Include medical diagnosis relevant to previous Ear Nose and Throat surgery/fractures/issues and any swallowing issues in addition to other medical history
