Honours Program Fees

Candidates selected for the Combined TPPP/Research Program will be responsible for fees associated with completing the Honours Program.

The indicative cost to undertake an Honours degree is approximately \$8945 and is based on the individual university topics that will be undertaken as part of the degree.

Students may be eligible for Commonwealth Supported Place (CSP), which is a place at a university or higher education provider where the government pays part of the student's fees. Commonwealth supported means the cost of the study is shared between the Australian Government and the student. Participants may be eligible for an Australian Government HECS-HELP loan. HECS-HELP is the government loan scheme that assists eligible Commonwealth supported students in payment their student contribution fees.
