Spasticity

- Spasticity is one of the components of upper motor neuron syndrome. It is the overactivity of the muscles following damage to the upper motor neuron.
- In this clinic, we provide a multidisciplinary approach, comprehensive assessment and management of spasticity, with aim to minimise its adverse functional impact and prevent associated complications.

Information Required for Referral

- Patient demographic information and contacts
- Principle diagnosis resulting in spasticity
- Main concern
- Current medication list
- Other co-morbidities
- Named referral
- Referring doctor's name and provider number
- · Date of referral
- Priority

Investigations Required

- Musculoskeletal X-ray if main concern is pain or/and joint deformity;
- · Neuro-image if principle diagnosis unclear

Red Flags



Unable to access hygiene due to severe spasticity / joint contracture deformity which can increase infection risk.



Uncontrolled spasticity may result in development or worsening of pressure sore

Increasing falls related to spasticity

Suggested GP Management

- Identify and treat triggering factor
- Consider oral anti-spasticity medication
- Urgent referral
